enforcement agencies were assigned to assist with the processing of a crime scene at Columbine High School, located in Jefferson County, Colorado.

Upon arrival at the Command Post located on Pierce Street by Clement Park, crime scene personnel were informed that the bomb squads of various agencies were in the process of clearing the school and the parking lot of explosive devices. At approximately 11:30 p.m., all crime scene personnel were instructed that processing of the scene would not start until the bomb squads had completed their activities; therefore, all crime scene personnel would report back to the command post on Wednesday, April 21, 1999 at 8:00 a.m.

ACTION TAKEN:

At 11:45 a.m. on April 21, 1999, Chris Andrist of the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office conducted a briefing for crime scene personnel. A plan was presented to divide the crime scene into specific areas and assign a team of four or five crime scene personnel to each area. A team leader was designated for each team.

Team Three consisted of the following personnel:

Team Three had been assigned to process the hallway running north to south in front of the library. Agent Crippin made the following team assignments:

- Cordell Brown – Photo Log Recorder
- Deputies Ralph Gallegos and Doug Moore (previously assigned as the evidence collection personnel for Team Three by Chris Andrist, Jefferson County Sheriff's Office) Evidence Custodians

Team Three members made an initial walk-through of the area at approximately 1:30 p.m. The initial impression of the hallway was that there had been two explosive devices that had detonated in

the area causing various areas of blast damage. Additionally, there was evidence of small arms being discharged in the area.

The processing of Team Three's area started at approximately 2:30 p.m. A closer inspection of the hallway was made and a plan of action developed. The hallway was divided into four sections and each section would be processed independently of the others. It was decided that overall photographs of the hallway would be taken and then the hallway would be video-taped. After these two things were done, the team personnel would walk the hallway and place evidence identification placards at items that would be collected as evidence. Team Three had been assigned #1200 through #1499 for evidence identification and collection. The hallway would then be sketched and measurements of any items to be collected as evidence would be noted. Team Three was later informed that a complete building sketch would be made by another agency and that they were not to reproduce this effort. The hallway would then be photographed and videotaped again with the evidence placards in place to show where the evidence to be collected was located. After this was done, the evidence would be collected.

After the hallway had been photographed and videotaped, the team members proceeded to identify possible items of evidence. Team Three identified 86 items of evidence that were to be collected. It was noted at this time that an explosive device had penetrated the wall into Team One's area. It was decided that Team Three would process two additional areas that had been originally assigned to Team One. Those areas were two rooms located off the north side of the main library room. Those rooms were processed after the hallway area was done.

Section #1 was the northernmost area while section #4 was the southernmost area. Sections #1, #2 and #3 measured 27 feet 5 inches in length and section #4 measured 28 feet in length. Sections #1, #2, #3 and #4 were separated by columns on the east side of the hallway that measured 30 inches wide by 21 inches deep. Opposite columns were noted separating #1 and #2 and #3 and #4 on the west side of the hallway. The column that would have been opposite the column separating section #2 and #3 was the main doorway into the library. Sections #1 and #4 each measured 16 feet 10 inches in width. Section #2 measured 16 feet 10 inches in width at the northern end and 23 feet 6 inches in width at the southern end. Section #3 measured 23 feet 6 inches in width at the northern end and 16 feet 10 inches in width at the southern end. The ceiling height in sections #1 through #4 was approximately 10 feet and the areas adjacent to the columns separating the individual sections was approximately 8 feet high.

Evidence from the floor areas in each section was removed first. Sections of the carpet where the devices had exploded were also removed. After the floor areas were cleared of evidence, attempts were made to collect any evidence that was located in the walls or ceilings.

- A section of wall above the lockers on the east side of section #1 approximately 55 inches from the column separating section #1 and #2 was removed in an attempt to recover possible shrapnel. A ceiling tile was also removed in this area in an attempt to recover possible shrapnel.
- Section #3 had an area of the carpet that showed blast damage. It was located 92 inches from the east wall, 201 inches from the west hallway wall and 111 inches from the corner of the elevator. This area was identified as item #1232 and a portion removed for analysis. Portions of the upper wall above the lockers on the east side of section #2 at the northernmost point, were removed in an attempt to locate pieces of possible shrapnel. Ceiling tiles were removed in the northernmost area of section #2 in an attempt to recover possible shrapnel that had passed through them. Several sections of the west wall were removed in an attempt to recover shrapnel. The initial walk-through had identified three separate areas of damage on the west wall of section #2 that had possibly been caused by shrapnel from the device that had detonated outside of the library entrance. Extensive damage was noted on this wall area. A section of wall was removed approximately 5 inches above the baseboard and 8 inches south of the left side of the elevator. A section of end cap (item #1226) was removed from the wall interior (Note – another section of the end cap had continued on through the opposite side of the wall causing damage in another room). A section of the west wall further south of the elevator had a partial explosive device (item #1240) imbedded in it. This appeared to be the device that had exploded in the area of the hallway in front of the library. The device had struck the wall approximately 6 inches above the baseboard. It had struck an inner structural support and did not penetrate the wall on the other side. Several casings were located by the elevator. Another section of wall on the west side of the hallway had shrapnel damage (item #1242) located 51 inches from the library entrance and 52 inches above the floor. The shrapnel penetrated the hallway wall, pierced an inner structural support and exited the back wall into a room just north of the main library area. There were several bullet holes on the north side of the column separating section #3 and section #4. There

were two small holes approximately 1 to 1 ½ feet from the floor and 1 large hole near the ceiling. The small holes looked like they could be 9mm and the large a shotgun slug. None looked like shrapnel holes. The opposite side of the column showed two holes down low and two large holes up high. It is thought that the shotgun slug split and caused the two upper holes. The holes were in a north to south direction. 9mm bullets and shotgun slug pieces were later recovered from the far south wall of the hallway by another team that could be traced back to these holes.

- Section #4 had an area that showed blast damage. It was identified as item #1261 and located 105 inches from the west hallway wall and 109 inches from the south edge of the column separating sections #3 and #4. A section of pipe (item #1263) was found against the west hallway wall and 100 inches from the west wall column. The west hallway wall had what appeared to be shrapnel damage (item #1280) approximately 16 inches above the floor and 106 inches from the west hallway wall column. Additionally the west wall above the southernmost bookcase had a single bullet hole in it approximately 1 to 1 ½ feet below the edge of the ceiling. The hole showed a east to west direction of travel and what ever had caused the hole had exited into the library through a comforter that was hanging on the east wall of the library above a bookcase. A 9mm bullet was later recovered by Team #1 in the ceiling of the east side of the library that had a trajectory indicating that it was from this hole. The opposite side of the hallway in section #4 (east side) was a wall composed of individual 3 foot by 3 foot glass panels. A blue plastic pager (item #1265) was found 44 inches from the east wall and 97 inches from the east hallway wall column. A green canvas bag containing several shotgun shells (item #1273) was located 7 inches from the east wall and 58 inches from the southernmost edge of section #4. One of the glass wall panels on the east side had been broken. This panel was located 156 inches from the east hallway wall column.

Sections #1, #2, #3 and #4 all had numerous pieces of grey duct tape, bits of carpet and large numbers of nails and shot pellets scattered throughout the floor areas.

Team Three personnel proceeded to the two rooms located just to the north of the main library area. The east room measured approximately 17 feet by 20 feet. It had doors located on the south, the west and the north walls. The west room measured approximately 20 feet by 19 feet. It had doors on the east, south and north sides. Both rooms were photographed and videotaped


prior to any evidence placards being put into place. After the evidence was identified and placards put into place, the rooms were again photographed and videotaped. The east wall of the easternmost room had two holes in it. Both holes had been caused by shrapnel penetrating them from the hallway wall on the other side. The southernmost hole corresponded with item #1242 and was further identified as item #1242A. It was located 55 inches above the floor and 12 inches from the south wall. A small piece of possible shrapnel was located on the opposite side of the room under a LCD projector. The northernmost hole corresponded with item #1226 and was further identified as item #1226A. It was located 7 inches above the floor and 18 inches from the north wall. A piece of pipe end cap (item #1226B) was located 59 inches from item #1226A. A spent shotgun shell (item #1285) was found 95 inches from item #1226A and 56 inches from the east wall. The west room had a TV set that had what appeared to be a bullet hole (item #1286) in the front of the picture tube. Fragments of a bullet were later recovered from inside of the television. The TV was located on a bench area in the approximate center of the room. An empty casing was found approximately 27 inches from the east wall and 33 inches from the north wall.


The processing of the library hallway and rooms north of the main library ended at approximately 8:45 p.m. on April 21, 1999.

Items collected from the hall included six spent 9mm cartridge cases, three spent Federal 12 gauge shot shells, two projectile fragments, three miscellaneous firearms-related items, and 49 pieces of explosive related evidence. In addition, two projectile fragments and one spent 9mm cartridge case were found in the AV room west of the hall.
