From November 15-17, 1999, I modified the diagram of the library to reflect corrections and additions as specified by Senior Lab Technician Tom Adair for Team 1 in the east side of the library. Adair told me the corrections and additions were based on review of scene photos and his original field notes. Adair provided additional notes and sketches to me at this time.

Items that were specifically measured are marked with an "X" according to their layer color for "floor", "elevated", or "ceiling". Those items that did not have specific measurements are now marked with an "O" according to their layer color to indicate an approximate location.

Dear Paula,

Enclosed is an updated disk for the evidence locations in Columbine Library.

Tom Adair specified the changes for the drawing after reviewing scene photos for Team One (1) at the Colorado Bureau of Investigation. I moved 15 items, deleted three duplicate numbers, changed the point layers on four items, added 20 item numbers, and added "X"s or "O"s on at least 10 items to locate the items better.

The items that needed to be moved were because of three reasons: 1) guesstimated location pending further information from Adair, 2) transposed positive/negative on coordinates, and 3) mis-read information.

Most of the added item numbers were from elevation sketches not previously provided to me.

Attached is a copy of my report detailing the changes.

On 4/20/99 at about 1445 hours I arrived at Littleton Porter Hospital to photograph victims from the shooting at Columbine High School. I was met by ACSO Investigators James Rasmussen, Kevin Heaton, Bruce Isaacson and Paul Goodman, and Detectives Michael Greenwell and George McGlynn of Lakewood PD.

I first photographed **Stephanie Munson, W/F, DOB 052682**, who had a bullet wound through and through at the top of her left ankle.

At about 1450 hours I photographed **Stephen "Austin" Eubanks, W/M, DOB 100781**, with wounds on the left knee, right little finger, and stitched right index finger.

At 1455 hours I photographed **Adam Kyler, W/M, DOB 062482**, who was in a neck brace. He stated he was hit by some object and not any bullets. There were no specific wounds to be photographed.

At 1520 hours I returned to the ACSO Lab to process the victim photographs.

At 1630 hours I was assigned to assist in processing the scene at Columbine High School at 6201 S. Pierce. I reported to Sgt. Beatty at the Command Post about 1500 hours. He informed me there would be a briefing at 1800 hours.

At about 1815 hours Chris Andrist of Jefferson County Sheriff's Office advised us that any pink flags found in the building were put there by bomb squad personnel. The pink flags were to indicate where bomb parts were or explosive devices had been and taken away to make safe.

At 1947 hours, Sgt. Randy West of JCSD gave another briefing to announce that SWAT and bomb personnel were still working on making devices safe, and making another sweep of the building. Nancy Bodelson, the Jefferson County Coroner would be in charge of identifying the bodies and we were not to touch the bodies.

At about 2100 hours, another briefing was held and we were told that more devices had been found in the school and in some cars so we would not be needed until the next day. I cleared the scene at about 2124 hours and then got paged to return at 2142 hours. I returned and was sent home again at 2305 hours.

On 04/21/99 at 0600 hours I returned to the Command Post parked near the school. Teams were assigned at about 0800 hours. I was assigned to Team Two which would be processing the west side of the library. Team Two was initially comprised of the following personnel:

The school and grounds were still being cleared of explosive devices at this time. Some ammunition was found on Pierce Street in front of the school so I joined a search line at about 0845 hours to see if any other potential evidence could be found. I did not find anything related to the crime.

At 1100 hours I assisted in getting evidence packaging materials ready at the inflated hazmat structure located just outside the main entrance of the school.

I was finally cleared for entry in the school building and was given a tour of the whole scene at 1350 hours on 4/21/99. I brought my equipment into the building at about 1423 hours to commence processing the scene.

I worked in tandem with Senior Lab Technician Tom Adair, who was part of Team One and sketching the diagram for the east side of the library. We agreed to label the west windows from 1 through 10 starting from the north and continuing southward, with "W 1" being in the northwest corner and "W 10" being in the southwest corner. The south windows were labeled 11 through 17 starting from the west and continuing to the east, with "W 11" being in the southwest corner and "W 17" being in the southeast corner.

The tables were also numbered. Tables 1 through 6 were in the eastern third of the library. Tables 7 through 14 were in the center third of the library. Tables 15 through 20 were in the western third of the library.

The rows of book cases running north/south were numbered, starting with "Row 1" along the east wall of the library. Rows 2, 3, and 4 were located to the west of tables #1-6. Rows 5, 6, and 7 were located to the west of tables #7-14. I designated the south sections of the book cases as Rows 5A and 6A. I designated the north sections of the book cases as Rows 5B and 6B. Row 8 was along the west wall below windows #7-10. There was also a book case for magazines along the north wall of the library (Team Two side) and a built-in book case behind the check-out desk (Team One side), but these were not numbered.

The basis for measuring were several base-lines. The main east/west baseline was set at the south side of the center island, which also lined up with the south side of the trophy case. This was arbitrarily chosen since it was one of the few unobstructed sight lines in the library. The main "EW Base" was located 47'10" away from the south wall. Two other east/west base-lines were laid out with tape measures taped to the carpet at two 10-foot intervals to the north of the main east/west base-line. The base referred to as "EW+10" runs between the two computer tables and just in front of the pillar at the southwest corner of the check-out desk (also referred to as the staff service counter) and was located 57'10" from the south wall. The base referred to as "EW+20" runs between the north wall and the northern computer table, and was located 67'10" from the south wall.


The north/south base-lines were also arbitrarily chosen based on the least obstructed sight-lines. The base-line referred to as "18-2 Base" was 18'2" east of the windows on the main E/W base. This ran roughly from the center of the southern computer table, past the southwest corner of Table #16, under Table #15, and about the center of the pillar at the southwest corner of the library. The base-line referred to as "31-Ft" was located 31 feet east of the windows on the main E/W base. This line runs between book case Rows 5 and 6, and between the east edge of the computer tables and the check-out desk. The other base-line in Team One's area is along the west edge of book case Row 4.

My assignment was to diagram and record the location of evidence in the west side of the library. The area encompassed: the windows; six tables placed at random; two computer tables placed east/west at the north end; four rows of book cases placed north/south; two microfiche viewers on tables, a magazine book case, and a typewriter table along the north wall. Two pillars immediately to the east of Row 5 provided the dividing line between Team One and Team Two.

The windows on the west side of the library sustained damage due to gun fire. Since the cracked areas of glass were not stable, and a weather front was moving in, priority was given to documenting the window area along the west wall. At about 1520 hours, CBI Agent Tom Griffin and I documented the windows using measurements written on Polaroid photos.

At about 1600 hours I began recording furniture dimensions. At about 1647 hours, after laying out a rough sketch, I began recording body measurements and locating evidence immediately around the bodies. I recorded locations for bodies B8, and B10-12. Tom Griffin recorded the locations for bodies B6-7 and B9.

I then continued with measuring items of evidence. I was assisted in measuring by several different people during the time I was at the scene. These included Tom Griffin of CBI, Matt Murray of Denver PD, Jennifer Savage of JCSD, and Peggy Rowlett of Wheat Ridge PD.

I worked on preparing a diagram on Autocad and turned over a copy of the file on disk to the FBI's Visual Specialist Paula Ernst on 5/6/99. This basically included the layout of the room and position of furniture and bodies.

Between 04/28/99 and 06/25/99 I worked on adding the location of all the evidence.
On 5/12/99 and 6/3/99, I met with Tom Griffin at CBI to compare photos of the scene with notes to verify positions of different pieces of evidence.

On 6/29/99, from 0900 to 1730 hours, I returned to the school and met with others originally at the scene (Griffin, Adair, Loptein, Rowlett, Jennings, Andrist) and DA Russ Boatwright to discuss the correlation of evidence with witness statements. As a result of reviewing more photos from the scene to the diagram prepared, and against the scene itself, I found that I needed to shift some chair positions, rotate the right foot of Eric Harris, and add a few items of evidence in the Team One area on the east side of the library.

Enclosed is the disk for the library, both Teams #1 and #2. The few missing locations for evidence on Team #1 side (east side) will be added after I can consult with Tom Adair.

Rather than give you select pages of notes for elevated views I am giving you all my notes. I believe I re-drew all the small sketches of chairs and table holes that were scattered through the notes on the latter "sketch" pages. One exception is the chair that was by B11 (Klebold).

I added a few notations to the window elevations that you received previously.

I didn't use any symbols to designate different types of evidence. The only coding is by color so far.

Chairs are separated by "trajectory" and "non-essential", meaning no evidence or trajectory was associated with the chairs. The only chair plotted in the service desk or check-out counter area was the one thrown on the counter.

I have not included the wall mounted televisions that were found in the northwest corner and the southeast corner, or the one between windows 10 and 11. No evidence was associated with the TVs.

Any evidence item number that is not marked with an "X" was not precisely measured and is only indicated relative to some other object. This occurs primarily in the east half and the north hallway. The stacked evidence item numbers found in the east half of the library and the north hallway are also relative placements.



The stacked evidence item numbers around the bodies of Klebold and Harris (B11 and B12) were pieces of clothing, evidence found within the clothing, or items of weaponry.

Tom Griffin, Agent with the Colorado Bureau of Investigation also indicated to me some "firearms discharge" events. Nothing has been done with these particular groupings, marked "FD"(number). These apparently will be further defined when all the firearms exams have been completed.

The designation of "shotgun related" was based on what I clearly knew to be shotgun type of ammunition parts. "Ammo related" refers to non-shotgun type of ammunition, a mixture of the two, or undistinguished.
