A single story ranch style structure, brown shingle roof, tan wooden upper portion, and a green and brown brick lower portion with green trim, and a two car attached garage on the east side. There is one window between the front door and garage. The front door is green with an oval shaped window in the middle, and there is one window to the west or right of the front door. The numbers "[REDACTED]" are black in color and are affixed to the left of the front door.

Upon one or more grounds set forth in Rule 41, Colorado Rules of Criminal Procedure and C.R.S. 16-3-302, as amended, namely:

- X Which is stolen or embezzled; or
- X Which is designed or intended for use as a means of committing a criminal offense; or
- X Which is or has been used as a means of committing a criminal offense; or
- X The possession of which is illegal; or
- X Which would be material evidence in a subsequent criminal prosecution in this state or in another state; or
- X Other: ANY DOCUMENTS AND/OR PAPERS TENDING TO SHOW OCCUPANCY OR CONTROL OF SAID OWNERSHIP.

I am satisfied that there is probable cause to believe that the property so described is located within the Premises above described, and that the grounds for this search warrant exist.

That the foregoing offense(s) alleged was committed of this affiant's own personal knowledge, and the facts stated therein are true.

Your affiant is of lawful age and a sworn peace officer of the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office, Golden, Colorado, in the County of Jefferson.

Your affiant states that the following facts are true and based upon his/her personal knowledge, as a result of his/her conversations with the person(s) named herein and reviewing their written reports.

On April 20, 1999, Investigator Gary Clyman, of the Colorado Attorney General's Office, was assigned to assist an investigation by the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office regarding multiple homicides, which occurred that date at Columbine High School, 6301 South Pierce Street, Littleton, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado, on April 20, 1999. Located at the crime scene was an explosive device shown to Investigator Clyman by Investigator Glenn Grove, of the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office. Investigator Grove said the device was identical to another he recovered on March 22, 1999 from a residence located at [REDACTED] Arvada, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado. The device was in the possession of a juvenile, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] dob/ [REDACTED]

Investigator Clyman reviewed the investigative report by Arvada Police Department. It indicates that [REDACTED] received the device from her friend, [REDACTED] dob [REDACTED], of [REDACTED], Arvada, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado. [REDACTED] told Investigator Greubel, of the Arvada Police Department, that he had learned to make the device from Eric Harris, who has been identified as one of the two suspects who committed the homicides at Columbine High School on April 20, 1999, and also placed the explosive devices found on the school premises. The other suspect is identified as Dylan Klebold, both allegedly members of the gang/group known as "Trench Coat Mafia" (TCM).

On April 21, 1999, Investigator Clyman spoke to [REDACTED] the father of [REDACTED]. He advised Investigator Clyman that after seeing the news reports of the incident at Columbine High School, he located in [REDACTED] possessions a notebook containing notes and sketches which may relate to the construction of explosive devices, and notes by [REDACTED] regarding her relationship with [REDACTED] and possibly others. [REDACTED] is presently in detention or a juvenile sentence to Mountview School, Division of Youth Services.

Based upon the aforementioned information, your affiant respectfully requests that the court issue a search warrant for the residence located at [REDACTED] County of Jefferson, State of Colorado, described as:

A single story ranch style structure, brown shingle roof, tan wooden upper portion, and a green and brown brick lower portion with green trim, and a two car attached garage on the east side.
