NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT

See Attached Log (Captain Sandoval and Sgt. Pinder)

On 4-20-99, members of the Denver Police Department responded to a Citywide call for help from the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department. The call came out on the Denver Police Department dispatch system at approximately 1132 HRS. Officers responded to the scene within minutes from most Police and Sheriff's Departments from the Metro area. Denver, Jefferson County S/O, Lakewood, and Arapahoe County Sheriff's Department set up their Command Posts at Leawood Ave & Pierce St. At approximately 1215 HRS, reporting Detective was assigned to act as aid and scribe to Captain Michael O'Neill. Captain O'Neill, known as Patrol one, was designated as the Commander of the Command Post.

145p Denver Mobile Command post arrived, Officer Lindel delivered additional radios, batteries (417,418b, 428, 438, 487, 427, 477).

145p Salvation Army arrived at Staging Area.
Lt. Wheeler and Sgt. Marker assigned to coordinate Staging Area at Peirce and Bowles.

145p Captain Sandoval that 25 officers were at Staging Area, assigned to double up outer perimeter.

Additional site named for parents and overflow of students. Church at Pierce and Ottawa. Calvary Church 933-0733, Library, and Leawood School. (Fax number 982-7861)

150p Victim's Assistance Supervisory (DPD) arrived and assigned to distribute V/A's to Leawood Elementary, the church, and the library. Organization of other sites and methods to collect information about students and parents.

Information from Jeffco that armor car from Ft. Carson would arrive in approximately 45 minutes.

200p Traffic officers sent to control intersection Leawood and Pierce.

200p Officer Chastain assigned to verify assignments on the outer perimeter.

Lt. Kreiger arrived with bomb dogs and assigned to coordinated with Sgt. D. Jones.

Media arriving at staging area. Verification by Victim's Assistance of activity at Columbine Library and Leawood Elementary.

210p Victim's Assistance Supervisor advised of sites involving victims. Church, Columbine Library, and Leawood Elementary.

211p Information aired concerning description of suspects.

Officer Depew provided information concerning possible location of suspects.

215p Salvation Army directed to Leawood and Peirce

220p Possible device located at Home Depot, abandoned in parking lot.

221p Traffic assigned to another channel. Capt. Gallagher monitored 5a for information and used to direct his personnel.

320p Notification of numbers of victims. Ambulances requested to stand by at Command Post for assignments.

Additional explosive devices discovered at Columbine High School.

335p Cellular Telephones arrived at staging area, used by victim assistance for students to contact parents, sent to Leawood and Library.

350p Students moved from Library/church to Leawood Elementary for debriefing at one main location.

405p Parent heart attack at Leawood Elementary, paramedics dispatched to assist.

420p Sgt. D. Fisher called and verified students being brought to Leawood Elementary, information-sharing taking place.

435p Jeffco crime lab advised not to enter school, additional explosive devices continually being found. Capt. Leary/DPD advised Capt. Sandoval that no one was to enter school/crime scene without authorization from him or Lt. Kitebush/Jeffco.

435p Sgt. D.Fisher advised that if additional designated telephone lines required notify him.

445p Update with Lt. Gehm/District Four concerning calls for service and logistic requirements of district.

445p Lt. Ryan relieved at Columbine School, advised that statements were required, for him to coordinate and submit to Capt. Sandoval.

500p Night Gang Unit Detail responding/ Contact person Sgt. Goodfellow/he was advised to contact Tac 2 at staging area. Capt. Gallagher advised to use gang unit to relieve officer at outer perimeter posts.

505p Sgt. Daiz and Officer Gallegos advised that they were relieved.
Barricades delivered to assist with closing of intersections.

510p Relief assignments verified by Captain Sandoval, two assignments left to be relieved.

520p Mounted Patrol Officers excused.
Sgt. Pinder advised to assign two Impact Officers with Officers Padilla and Tran at Kennedy and Lincoln High School for 4/21/99.

545pm Night Gang Bureau Detail arrived at staging area to assist in relief efforts.

Summary of Statement:

ON April 20, 1999 AT ABOUT 11:30 AM I WAS INFORMED BY DET. ED. HERTZING (BOMB SQUAD) THAT THERE WAS A HOSTAGE SITUATION AND SHOOTING AT COLUMBINE HIGH SCHOOL. I IMMEDIATELY RESPONDED TO THE AREA. WHILE EN ROUTE, THE DISPATCHER (CHNL #5) ADVISED THAT OFFICERS WERE NEEDED AT YUKON AND POLK TO HELP EVACUATE STUDENTS FROM THE SCHOOL. I ALTERED MY ROUTE AND RESPONDED TO THAT LOCATION. YUKON & POLK IS A DEAD-END STREET BUT ALLOWS ACCESS TO A WALKWAY IN CLEMENT PARK & TO THE SOUTH ATHLETIC FIELDS AND PARKING LOT AREA OF THE HIGH SCHOOL.

UPON MY ARRIVAL AT THE YUKON AREA (ABOUT NOON) I OBSERVED THE INTERSECTION roped off w/ POLICE LINE TAPE. SEVERAL STUDENTS WERE PRESENT, SOME WOUNDED & BLEEDING AND SOME NOT PHYSICALLY WOUNDED BUT OBVIOUSLY IN MENTAL DISTRESS. THE PHYSICALLY WOUNDED WERE BEING TENDED TO BY MEDICAL PERSONNEL. I RECOGNIZED TWO

Summary of Statement (cont.) students sitting on the curb, Josh Lapa and Andrew Fair. As I approached the scene, neither of these young men were able to provide me with information. After consoling them back to a semi-calm state, I observed that Lt. Tony Ryan (Denver P.D.) was the highest ranking officer at the scene. I made contact with Lt. Ryan and advised him that I am extremely familiar with the layout of the school (I have 3 sons attending the school and had been in a east classroom earlier that morning) Lt. Ryan inquired as to a position for an observation post. I pointed out a hill known to me as "Mount Mitchell" and offered to drive him to that point. My police vehicle (Unit L8035) is a 1999 Chevrolet 4x4 Truck - green in color. After arriving atop Mt. Mitchell we observed several officers close-in toward the school. We were joined atop Mt. 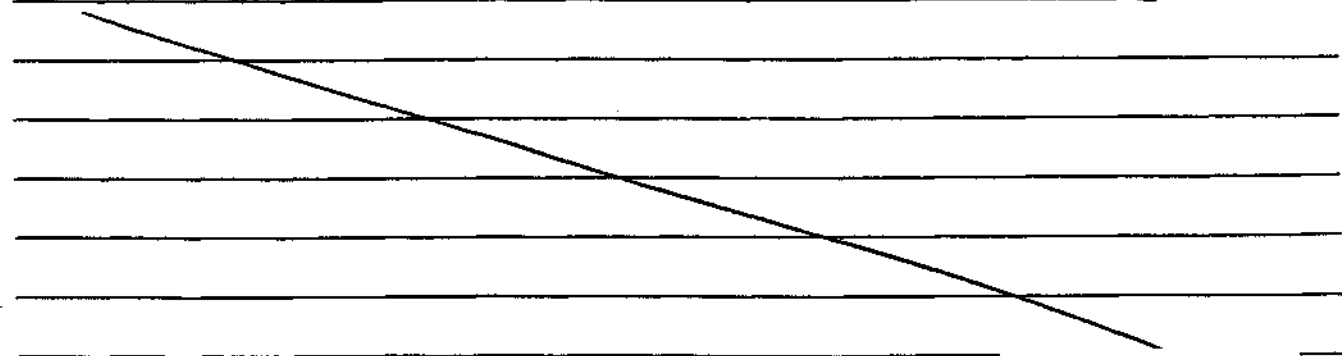

The call came out on the Denver Police Department dispatch system at approximately 1132 HRS. Officers responded to the scene within minutes from most Police and Sheriff's Departments from the Metro area. Denver, Jefferson County S/O, Lakewood, and Arapahoe County Sheriff's Department set up their Command Posts at Leawood Ave & Pierce St. At approximately 1215 HRS, reporting Detective was assigned to act as aid and scribe to Captain Michael O'Neill. Captain O'Neill, known as Patrol one, was designated as the Commander of the Command Post.

1215 HRS

A request was made through Police Dispatch for the Mobile Command Post to respond to Leawood ave & Pierce St.

Captain Sandoval was assigned to Command the outside Perimeter.

Captain Gallagher was assigned to Command the Traffic (S.O.B.) units.

Metro SWAT units were arriving and set up just to the South of the Command Post and their commander began to consult with Patrol one and Jefferson County Command Post.

Jefferson County S/O requested Denver units deploy to the south of the school to assist their unit. Officers from Dist. 4 responded immediately.

1220 HRS

Officers from Dist. 4 aired that they were taking fire and needed paramedics for a number of wounded students. Jeffco/Fire & Littleton Fire & Paramedics were notified.

JC- 001-009641

Denver SWAT units immediately responded to cover the Dist. 4 Officers and Paramedics on the south side of the building.

A decision was made and aired to have all Officers inform arriving parents to respond to Leawood Elementary for information and a location to be reunited with their children as they exited the school or were rescued.

Denver Officers were dispatched to direct traffic at all intersections around the perimeter. The main intersection was Bowles ave & Pierce St.

1225 HRS

Captain O'Neill requested that V.A. staff from Denver respond immediately to assist with students, parents, and School staff. The V.A. staff were directed to respond to the Command Post to obtain their assignments. The majority of the V.A. staff were assigned to Leawood Elementary.

1230 HRS

SWAT Units from a number of different Departments arrived and suited up by the Command Post and were given their assignments to coordinate with the Jefferson County SWAT for entry to the School.

An area adjacent to the Command Post was cleared for additional ambulances & Fire as well as arriving paramedics.

Patrol One attended a briefing in the Jefferson County Mobile Command Post. The initial reports revealed a confirmation of seven gunshot victims but the number was expected to be higher from radio reports from Officers on the South side of the school. Jefferson County Command Post supervisor, Lt. Walcher, stated that at least two suspects had been observed in the school with "long" guns. Division Chief Whitman arrived and was briefed and maintained a position at the Command Post. Deputy Chief Abrams arrived at the scene and was briefed.

Det. Arellano was ordered by Patrol one to take a position at leawood ave & Pierce and direct all arriving SWAT team Officers where to join their units.

1240 HRS

Another briefing/meeting with the Jefferson County Command Post was held in their Mobile unit. The decision was made to take students to Leawood Elementary as they were rescued. Obtain a list of all names of students. Students were to be frisked as they escaped or rescued to ensure that the suspects did not escape in the crowd.

Information was received that a natural gas leak was occurring in the school. A decision was made to have Public Service shut off the gas as soon as it was safe to approach the main valve. A crew from PSC was present and was notified to be ready to accompany officers.

Sgt. Marker was directed by Patrol One to Supervise the intersection of Bowles & Pierce St. due to the number of Police units arriving and the congestion. Officers were directed to move any Police car that was blocking Pierce St. and to keep one lane open. Sgt. Jones assisted in moving Police units onto the grass adjacent to Pierce St.

A report of more shots fired on the North side of the School.

1247 HRS

Patrol one ordered Det. Teiken to Fair & Marshall to assist with crowd control. Additional Officers from Denver & Lakewood sent to assist with crowd control.

Call aired to all officers on all responding agencies to move their vehicles on Pierce St. to allow necessary emergency vehicles access to the School. Information from Jeff/Co that a National Guard armored vehicle would be arriving and needed additional room on Pierce St.

1257 HRS

Officer Creason was directed by Patrol one to assist Lt. Fink.

1258 HRS

Captain Gallagher requested to Command the outer perimeter.

1300 HRS

The Denver Police Department Bomb squad arrived at the scene and were assigned to team up with the Jefferson County Bomb unit.

An FBI commander arrived at the scene and requested to be admitted to the Jeff/Co Mobile Command Post. Reporting Detective brought the FBI commander in the trailer.

Captain Sandoval was notified that more Police radios and batteries were needed. Reporting Detective contacted Dist. 4 and directed all extra Dist. 4 radios and batteries were to be sent to the Command Post ASAP. Officer Lindel was assigned to transport.

Administrators from the School were brought to the Command Post and debriefed by Jeff/Co.

1315 HRS

Radio Room contacted Patrol one to notify the Mobile command Post to turn on their FAX machine and to have Det. Metzler to call the radio room and give them their mobile telephone numbers.

Patrol One directed reporting Detective to contact Jeff/Co Detectives and obtain the names of the suspects and give them to 4 X-Ray 16.

Det. Kickbush of Jeff/Co and an unknown female Detective gave the following names of suspects:

Received radio reports of more victims and more gunshots from the southwest area of the School. A request for Paramedics and Ambulances was received in the Command Post. Staskin briefed the Littleton Fire Chief on the radio traffic and the request and numerous Paramedics were dispatched.

A report came into the Command Post that more shots were heard in the School. (later determined to be a device used by Lakewood SWAT to blow a door)

A report came into the Command Post that no other suspects were located and that the School appeared to be secured.

Requests from Jeff/Co for the assistance of the Denver Police Crime Lab Units and Denver Homicide.

1700 HRS

A number of the Police and Sheriff's Departments began to secure and leave the scene.

1815 HRS

Patrol One informed reporting Detective to secure and gave permission return to Dist. 4.

After we were released from that location we returned to headquarters.
